Since its inception, this highly dedicated volunteer chorus, whose membership draws from all areas within greater Denver, has literally given voice to the legacy and culture of the Jewish experience through song. Now in its twentieth season, the Colorado Hebrew Chorale retains its commitment to communal service as its *raison d'être*.

For more than thirty years, Carol Kozak Ward has been an educator, performer, conductor and specialist in the Hebrew choral repertoire. In addition, she is an advocate of contemporary choral music, having commissioned such composers as Gerald Cohen, Martin Bresnick, and Pulitzer Prize-winner Aaron Jay Kernis, and includes works of the present day in her programs. Carol holds a Master of Music degree in Choral Conducting from Yale University School of Music, an M.A. in Music Education from Teachers College, Columbia University, and a B.A. in Near Eastern Studies from New York University. Originally from Connecticut, Carol and her family lived in Haifa, Israel for six years before relocating to Colorado in 1991.
